## Proposed CIHC Legislation (Cathy, Ed)

### **Proposed CIHC Bill**

- Cathy provided an update on status
- Assemblyman Chu will not carry the bill, despite initial comments from his office
- Cathy is working to engage
   Assemblyman Cooper, Senator
   Pan, Assemblyman Ping, and
   others to attempt to get a sponsor
   for the bill
- An option is to place the bill as a spot bill or to incorporate it into another pre-existing proposed bill that already has sponsorship
- <u>Cathy</u> is looking for other organizations to sponsor the bill
- Current feedback from those declining sponsorship is that the bill is "special interest" and therefore is not popular with legislators.
- Potential support from WorkSafe, WOEMA, and CA Medical Association

**YWS Initiative** 

- Senator Pan's office is interested in modifying their current bill to support young worker safety
- <u>Cathy</u> is working to finalize resolution for Young Worker Safety month in May
- Chris provided comments that CIHC's role is to add value to existing programs and not divert the efforts of others
- <u>Richard</u> provided updates on the YWS program initiative
