

Before Solutions – The Problem

OSHA –

- Not Enough Resources
 - OSHA Budget Less Than Cost to Guard Embassy and Personnel in Baghdad
- Convoluted Regulatory Process
 - 7 Health Standards in Last 20 Years 6 in 1978 Alone
- Outdated Exposure Limits
 - Thousands with None
 - Industry Says Limits Too High
 - Labor Says Limits Too Low

23,901 Notices – These Included Guidelines
